4. S&T services that have created a national/visible impact

• Root cause analysis of failure of runner of unit #1 M/s NHPC Limited

The generating unit#1 of Kishanganga power station of M/s NHPC Limited was put into commercial run . Frequently, the runner faced breakage problems especially from the root of the bucket. one such Pelton bucket attached to the runner of unit#1 was failed and subsequently the bucket was sent to CSIR-NML for failure investigation. The investigations included : a) Visual observation and photography b) Chemical analysis c) Mechanical property evaluation: Hardness test and Charpy V-notch impact test, Tensile test, Fatigue Test d) Microstructural analysis: Optical Microscopy (OM), Scanning Electron Microscopy(SEM), Energy Dispersive X-Ray Spectroscopy (EDS) e) Fractography f) X-Ray Diffraction (XRD) analysis and g) Data analysis. The recommendations were handed over to the Party.




• CSIR-Foundation Day Celebrations
